

## Example: In-person vs. online tuition and fees

### AGRICULTURAL TECHNICAL INSTITUTE — AUTUMN SEMESTER 2020

The Ohio State University has a single tuition model for students who are taking all or some of their courses in person or in a blended mode ("hybrid" or "distance enhanced") on our campuses. There is a different structure for fully online ("distance learning").

To illustrate the difference, the following table shows the tuition and mandatory fees for full-time students who are new first year undergraduates entering in autumn 2021. The table shows the full-time rates for the Agricultural Technical Institute in Wooster.
